From Harlingen:

1. Take the Sam Houston exit.
2. Make a left under the overpass.
3. Going down Sam Houston Street you will pass a set of 2 traffic lights (Robertson, then Stenger).
4. At the third traffic light, Business 77, you will turn right on Business 77. (There is a convenience store on the right corner of Sam Houston and Business 77.)
5. Head down Business 77 about 2 miles until you reach a set of yellow blinking lights.
6. Turn left on Farm Road 510.
7. Go down Farm Road 510 for about a mile.
8. At the red blinking lights/stop sign turn right.
9. As soon as you turn right, on the left hand side is the County Barn and the Animal Shelter entrance is the last left unpaved entrance.

From Brownsville:

1. Take the Sam Houston exit.
2. Make a right on Sam Houston.
3. Going down Sam Houston Street you will pass a set of 2 traffic lights (Robertson, then Stenger).
4. At the third traffic light, Business 77, you will turn right on Business 77. (There is a convenience store on the right corner of Sam Houston and Business 77.)
5. Head down Business 77 about 2 miles until you reach a set of yellow blinking lights.
6. Turn left on Farm Road 510.
7. Go down Farm Road 510 for about a mile.
8. At the red blinking lights/stop sign turn right.
9. As soon as you turn right, on the left hand side is the County Barn and the Animal Shelter entrance is the last left unpaved entrance.
