QUALIFICATIONS: High School graduate or GED equivalency, and certified Health Educator, or Community Health Worker Training and certification program, plus two (2) years of full-time employment as a Health Educator, or Community Health Worker, Or Bachelor's Degree in public health, social services or related field. Ability to communicate effectively in Spanish/English as well as be sensitive to the Mexican-American/Hispanic community. Skillful in speaking before groups of people, including health care providers. Ability to work independently and cooperatively as a team leader, or member. Must have a valid Texas Driver's License, comply with State of Texas Driving Las, and maintain an acceptable driving record. Must have reliable transportation. Employees of Cameron County may be required to work during any natural disaster or emergency. Criminal background check is required for employment or continued employment.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Cameron County Public Health Emergency Preparedness Director or designee. Assists in providing Zika outreach and Zika community educational activities by working collaboratively with department staff as well as community-based agencies, organizations, and health care providers with the purpose of keeping them informed on the most up-to-date Zika information released by the CDC, Department of State Health Services, and/or the Cameron County Public Health (CCPH). Actively promotes services and events offered through CCPH as part of any Zika response efforts deemed necessary. Position requires strong interpersonal skills as well as being sensitive to ethnicity, language, socio-economic status, and life experiences while conducting community activities and strong professional skills while conducting activities with the health care providers. Performs other duties as assigned. This is not a Civil Service covered position.

Employment for this position is guaranteed until 7/31/2019.
