**QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from High School or General Educational Development (GED) certificate, and/or two (2) years of experience in a related field; Knowledge of safety standards and practices; Skill in the operation of hand and power tools; Ability to follow verbal and written instructions, ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, County employees and the general public. Must have a valid Texas Driver's License; May be required to work more than 40 hours during the work week; Required to be on call 24 hours a day. Must have experience in concrete (curb and gutter/sidewalk). Physical requirements include frequent carrying/lifting of 10-25 lbs. and 50-100 lbs. occasionally. Visual acuity speech and hearing, subject to stooping, crawling, kneeling, handling, twisting, reaching, pushing and balancing to perform the essential functions. Working conditions are primarily outside with exposure to temperature variations, occasional exposure to damp/wet surfaces, dusty conditions, fumes and odors, flammable liquids and high noise levels.

**DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:** Under general supervision, is responsible for performing a variety of manual tasks operating hand and power tools, performs road maintenance and road construction work; Performs road maintenance, brush cutting, trimming and trash removal; Performs manual labor at construction sites. Assists paving crew in the construction of roads, flagging vehicles to direct traffic on road construction sites for public safety. Picks up and disposes of trash, tires, brush and dead animals; Performs related duties as required. Must submit to a drug and alcohol evaluation. This is not a Civil Service covered position.
