Must have the ability to follow written and oral instructions and work in a mature, professional and outdoor setting. Ability to negotiate, perform tasks without supervision and make quick decisions. Working conditions are primarily outdoors. Will be required to drive County owned vehicles and other equipment as needed. Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License and maintain an acceptable driving record.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Under supervision of the County Park Ranger and Park Director. Responsible for patrolling Cameron County Public Beaches conducting County property inspections; enforces park policies/rules, regulations and County ordinances; Responsible for issuing citations to violators for breaking any County and State policies, rules, regulations, and/or ordinances. Performs related duties as assigned and required. Weekday, Weekend, and Holiday work and shift work schedule will be required along with other duties as assigned. On special emergencies or occasional projects, may require working in other County Parks as assigned. This is not a Civil Service covered position.
