QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in either Public Health, Entomology, OR, a High School diploma and four (4) years of experience performing the full scope of vector control investigative and technical work and basic knowledge and understanding of vector control duties in the environmental field. Knowledge of state laws and local orders regarding general sanitation regulations. Knowledge of vector control rules and regulations. Must have strong skills in statistics and be able to create table chart reports in Excel. Ability to set mosquito surveillance traps, collect and handle mosquitoes collected. Ability to fill out daily reports. Ability to operate adding machine to accurately calculate totals. Ability to organize presentations/workshops as they are required to work during any natural disaster or emergency. Ability to work after hours, weekends, and holidays. Must have a valid Texas Driver's License, comply with State of Texas Driving Laws, and maintain an acceptable driving record. Must have reliable transportation. Criminal background check is required for employment or continued employment.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Environmental Health Director or designee, works closely with both local municipalities and the Texas Department of State Health Services to enhance the current Vector Control Response Plan. Will be responsible to coordinate and execute large scale vector response plans, by coordinating a cache of resources available to respond during a vector control event; works with Health Inspector Supervisor and local municipalities to coordinate adulticide and larvicide activities for mosquitoes and larva to mitigate the spread of vector borne disease. Obtains bids, purchase orders for equipment, supplies, chemical and other necessary resources. Performs other duties as assigned. This is not a Civil Service covered position.
