TO CERTAIN RESIDENT, QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF CAMERON COUNTY:

TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held in the Cameron County on November 7, 2017 as provided in an ORDER CALLING AN ELECTION duly passed by the Commissioners Court of said County on August 15, 2017. Portions of which are provided as follows:

ORDER CALLING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN CAMERON COUNTY, TEXAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 387, TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Cameron County, Texas (the "Court") hereby finds and determines that an election should be held to determine (i) whether the Court in Cameron County, Texas (the "County") shall be authorized to establish and create the Cameron County Assistance District No. 1 (the "District"); and (ii) the imposition of a sales and use tax at a rate of 2% within the boundaries of the District for the purpose of financing the operations of the District, all in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 387, Texas Local Government Code (the "Act"), and other applicable law;

WHEREAS, the Court finds that creation of the District and imposition of the 2% sales and use tax within the District's boundaries will not result in the combined sales and use tax imposed in any portion of the District to exceed the maximum combined rate permitted by applicable law;

Proposition. An election shall be held on the 7th day of November, 2017, a uniform election date, in the County Of Cameron, Texas, which date is 78 or more days from the date of the adoption of this Order for the purpose of submitting the following propositions to the qualified voters of the County:

CAMERON COUNTY PROPOSITION A

"Shall the Commissioners Court of Cameron County, Texas be authorized to establish and create the Cameron County Assistance District No. 1 (the "District") and authorize the imposition of a sales and use tax at a rate of 2% within the boundaries of the District for the purpose of financing the operations of the District, all in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 387, Texas Local Government Code?"

Voting Hours and Polling Places. Voting shall take place on Election Day between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M., at the polling places, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if copied in full.

Early Voting. (a) The early voting clerk for said election shall be Remi Garza, Cameron County Elections Administrator. Early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance and by mail or other lawful means. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of regular business (or noon, if later) October 27, 2017. Applications for ballots by mail for contract carrier delivery, as well as marked ballots, should be sent to the following address:

Excepted from inclusion within the boundaries of the Cameron County Assistance District No. 1 are those areas that are within the incorporated boundaries of the following municipalities: City of Brownsville, City of Harlingen, City of San Benito, City of La Feria, City of Los Fresnos, City of Port Isabel, City of Rio Hondo, City of Palm Valley, Town of Primera, Town of Laguna Vista, Town of Combes, Town of Santa Rosa, Town of South Padre Island, Town of Rancho Viejo, Town of Los Indios, Town of Indian Lake, Town of Bayview, and the Village of Rangerville, Texas. The Metes and Bounds of each aforementioned political subdivision is a matter of record in each respective municipality and in the records of the Cameron County Clerk's office.
