Assistant District Attorney Rollins receives Inspector General Integrity Award from U. S. Department of Health and Human Services

Brownsville, Texas – August 3, 2010 – Armando R. Villalobos, County and District Attorney for Cameron County, announces today that Assistant District Attorney Stephanie Rollins is the recipient of the Inspector General Integrity Award from the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services.

The Inspector General Integrity Award is given to individuals or organizations that help fulfill the mission of the Office of the Inspector General, to protect the integrity of the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services programs and its beneficiaries.

Rollins is the prosecutor for the White Collar Crime Unit of the Cameron County and District Attorney's Office. The White Collar Crime Unit investigates fraud and theft often associated with one's place of employment or social status, and can include embezzlement, misapplication of fiduciary property, Medicaid fraud, insurance fraud, or schemes that affect the economic rights of victims.

"I would like to thank the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services for this prestigious honor and Mr. Villalobos for the opportunity to prosecute white collar crime," Assistant District Attorney Stephanie Rollins said.

Rollins received her law degree from the University of Texas School of Law in 2006 and began working with the Villalobos administration that same year. She received her bachelor's degree in English Literature in 2003 from Southern Methodist University.
