Cameron County Justice Courts to Participate in Warrant Round-Up

Beginning March 5, 2016 more than 300 law enforcement agencies across Texas will kick off a massive effort known as the Texas Warrant Roundup to address debt owed on outstanding cases. If you do not resolve your tickets between February 19 and March 4, 2016, you may be subject to arrest. If you are stopped while driving your vehicle and arrested, your vehicle may be impounded, which would result in additional tow and storage fees. Please take care of your tickets now to avoid possible arrest.

Courtesy notices are being sent out to those who have outstanding violations to remind and give them an opportunity to take care of their tickets between now and March 5th. If you voluntarily appear at any of county locations to take care of your tickets with Cameron County Justice Courts, you will not be arrested. In addition, if you are unable to pay you may contact the court to discuss options that may be available to resolve your matters with the Court.
