


INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into and between the COUNTY OF CAMERON, TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and the CITY OF SANTA ROSA, hereinafter referred to as "CITY", pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code, Chapter 791, cited as the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

1. LOCATION OF PROJECT: Cameron County (Santa Rosa, Texas).
2. PROJECT TO BE COMPLETED: Reconstruction and Pavement Improvements on N. Parker Rd. (RR to San Roman Avenue – City Portion).
3. The total estimated material cost contribution which will be provided by the City of Santa Rosa to construct this portion of N. Parker Rd. is \$65,676.56. City will pay \$65,676.56 of this amount for materials, labor and equipment, and contingency to the COUNTY at the beginning of the N. Parker Rd. project. County will be responsible for providing all labor and equipment for the road reconstruction and pavement improvements in accordance with the cost estimate provided as Attachment "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as is fully set forth herein. COUNTY will be responsible for providing the labor and equipment for the road reconstruction and pavement improvements of N. Parker Rd. which is estimated to cost the COUNTY \$25,707.85 in accordance with Attachment "A". The COUNTY will solely be responsible for providing labor and equipment to reconstruct the road identified in this Interlocal Agreement in accordance with Attachment "A". County will not pay for any utility or right of way preparation of documents for this project.
4. COUNTY intends to make improvements to N. Parker Rd. from Railroad to San Roman Avenue as soon as is practicable but no later than the end of the 2016-2017 fiscal year and will initiate construction of N. Parker Rd. in 2016 once Interlocal Agreements between Cameron County and the City of Santa Rosa are approved. County understands the financial conditions of the city and will allow for two payments to be made by the City to the County in 2017.
5. This agreement constitutes a one-time agreement between the parties and does not constitute a continuing agreement or responsibility for maintenance of the subject project. Any future maintenance will be determined by both parties prior to work taking place.
6. The rules, regulations and orders of COUNTY shall govern this agreement and the parties agree the COUNTY shall supervise the performance of this agreement. It is also agreed that the COUNTY has the authority to employ personnel to engage in other administrative services necessary to fulfill the terms of this agreement.
7. The agreement shall have no legal force or effect until such time as it is properly adopted and approved by the CAMERON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT and the CITY OF SANTA ROSA. This agreement shall terminate at the completion of the project.
8. Any payments made under this Agreement will be made from the current revenues of the paying party.
