JUDGE CALLS FOR VOLUNTARY RELOCATION OF HIGH PROFILE VEHICLES

Cameron County Judge Carlos H. Cascos has ordered a voluntary relocation of all high profile vehicles that are in the Isla Blanca and Andy Bowie (County Parks). All individuals with RV's or other high profile vehicles should consider taking precautionary measures to relocate immediately.

"We continue to monitor Tropical Storm Alex as it makes its way through the Gulf of Mexico with a trajectory into northern Mexico and Southern Texas. According to the latest advisory the storm is on a track to affect the Gulf Coast Texas region," Judge Carlos Cascos stated.

Judge Cascos has also already ordered all public works crews to begin taking all the necessary precautions in preparation for the hurricane season by cleaning out ditches, continuing to bag sandbags and pre-positioning some of our heavy equipment and water pumps in the low lying areas of the county.

"Our crews are on standby and ready to mobilize at a moments notice", Cascos stated.
