



Cameron County CIAP 2009-2010 Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Where must projects be located in order to qualify for funding under the Cameron County CIAP program?

A: Wholly contained within Cameron County

Q: What is the maximum amount we can apply for?

A: There is no maximum amount. Minimum Grant Proposal Amount is \$100,000.00. Proposals under \$100,000.00 will not be accepted.

Q: Which Texas counties are eligible for funding through the CIAP program?

A: Coastal Management Program boundaries or within the jurisdictional boundaries of The following counties: Aransas, Brazoria, Calhoun, Cameron, Chambers, Galveston, Harris, Jackson, Jefferson, Kennedy, Kleberg, Matagorda, Nueces, Orange, Refugio, San Patricio, Victoria and Willacy.

Q: Who is eligible to receive CIAP funding?

A: State agencies
Federal agencies
Universities
Municipal & Local Governments
Subdivision of the State
Non-profit organizations

Q: How much CIAP money will my county receive?

A: Cameron County will be receiving a combined \$1,393,313.00(FY 09-\$700,249 & FY 10-\$693,064)

Q: Who is the CIAP point of contact for Cameron County?

A: For information regarding the Cameron County CIAP program contact the Cameron County Parks & Recreation Office. For information regarding the State CIAP program contact the Texas General Land Office.

Q: Who makes the final decision as to whether a project is funded?

A: For the State of Texas Plan the final decision is made by the Governors office. For County Plan the final decision is made by the Cameron County Commissioners Court.
