2. What is the role of DR Consultants, LLC and/or W.G. Yates & Sons Construction Company in regard to this RFQ and Pre-Planning for Post-Hurricane Recovery Operation support?

W.G. Yates & Sons Construction Company is contracted with Cameron County to provide support and consulting services in the management of various service contracts that might be activated in the event of an emergency such as a hurricane or other disaster. Additionally, we function in the same capacity for the county with respect to Pre-Planning for Post Hurricane Recovery Operations. Should an "event" occur, Yates will be in the EOC and will work alongside Cameron County to assist with Emergency Operations support. DR Consultants, now Resilire, is our subconsultant.

3. Page 11, FEE. States a total fee not to exceed \$14,999. Is this the value of the scope of work or is this an error? Possibly a carryover from another RFQ.

This is a carry over from a past RFQ. Should read "COUNTY agrees to pay CONSULTANT on a time and materials basis for services provided in accordance with "Attachment 3", FEES.

6. Is there a maximum response time required? i.e. Consultants shall be in Cameron County at the site of the disaster with 48 hours after being activated.  
*Consultant shall be on site of disaster within 24 hours of being activated.*
7. P.23 Section 3. County Projects. We interpret county to mean Cameron County projects. Is this correct, and if so, if we do not have any prior work with the county will we be disqualified? How much weight in evaluating the RFQ response does this hold?  
*Yes, "COUNTY" is referring to Cameron County. If Consultant has no past experience with Cameron County this will NOT be grounds for disqualification. This should not deter Proposer from submitting RFQ and will not prevent a firm from being selected (based on this requirement).*
