QUALIFICATIONS: Must have high school diploma or equivalent and basic knowledge and understanding of animal control duties in the environmental field. Must currently possess or obtain within three months of employment the Animal Control Officer Certification. Knowledge of animal control rules/ordinances and regulations. Ability to work after hours, weekends, and holidays. Maintain a valid Texas Drivers License and acceptable driving record.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Environmental Health Director or designee. Picks up stray unwanted animals in rural areas of Cameron County. Puts to sleep and properly disposes of animals collected. Answers/investigates animal complaints, issuing live animal traps to public. Conducts home visits on animal/victims involved in animal bites/attacks. Prepares animal specimens for rabies testing. Maintains cleans the animal shelter. Feeds/water animals kept at shelter. Works after hours, weekends, and holidays on emergency calls reported by Sheriff's Department. Assists on annual rabies clinics. Other duties as assigned. This position is subject to a six month probation period prior to Civil Service eligibility. Must submit to a Civil Service clerical exam.

BENEFITS: Cameron County offers excellent fringe benefits, including: health and life insurance protection, sick and annual leave, a retirement system and paid holidays.
