DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Captain and / or Administrator. The Boot camp's primary goal is to provide an alternative placement for adjudicated juveniles through a community-based, correctional program. The long range goals are designed to provide a disciplined environment, rule-oriented training, emphasis on education to allow for the successful re-integration of the juvenile client into the community and the family unit. Performs other related duties as assigned. This is not a Civil Service position.
