Must have a valid Texas Driver's License and may be required to work more than forty hours during the work week.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: This is a responsible non-supervisory position. Responsible for performing a variety of manual tasks operating hand and power tools. Performs road maintenance and road construction work, brush cutting, trimming and trash removal. Assists paving crew in road construction of roads, flagging vehicles to direct traffic on road construction sites for public safety, picks up and disposes of trash, brush and dead animals, other duties as assigned. This position is subject to a six months probation period prior to Civil Service eligibility. Must submit to a Civil Service drug and alcohol exam.
